

Vermont Educators' Bill of Rights Endorsement Process

Vermont-NEA will be putting together Toolkits for each individual Local. The kits will contain a copy of the Bill of Rights, Endorsement Sheets, 10 Minute Meeting Scripts, Story Corps instructions and a few other items.

2

Kits will be available for pickup at the RA, and distributed to locals at the April RBC.

3

RBC attendees will explain the Bill of Rights to Executive Committee members at their April/May meeting. Each local will then disburse the items in their toolkits to their Building Reps to take back to each individual worksite.

4

Building Reps will have a 10-minute meeting with members to collect endorsements from members in their buildings. Take photos of the action to send to Vermont-NEA.

5

After all worksites in a Local have endorsements from their members we'd like Building Reps to bring the signing sheets back to the next Executive Committee meeting and report out.

6

Once all worksites have endorsed, then the Executive Committee will endorse the Bill of Rights, (take photos). Return all endorsement sheets to Vermont-NEA.
